## Highlights

- Towering dunes surrounding Sossusvlei

**Day 1 | Friday**  
**NAMIB DESERT**  
Departing Windhoek, we travel to the Namib Desert. This is the gateway to Sossusvlei, with some of the highest dunes in the world. The afternoon is spent relaxing at the pool or taking part in optional activities offered at our lodge  
**Classic: Overnight at The Elegant Desert Lodge.**  
**Superior: Overnight at Sossusvlei Lodge Dinner.**

**Day 2 | Saturday**  
**SOSSUSVLEI / NAMIB DESERT**  
Entering the Namib Naukluft National Park shortly after sunrise. Be captivated by the surreal Deadvlei and Sossusvlei. Continue to the Sesriem Canyon, before returning to our lodge to enjoy the afternoon at leisure.  
**Classic: Overnight at The Elegant Desert Lodge - Breakfast.**  
**Superior: Overnight at Sossusvlei Lodge Breakfast and dinner.**

**Day 3-4 | Sunday - Monday**  
**SWAKOPMUND**  
Continue your journey to Solitaire, on the edge of the Namib Naukluft National Park, before travelling via the Kuiseb Valley towards the Atlantic Ocean.

Reaching the coastal harbour town of Walvis Bay, visit the shallow lagoon, before continuing along the scenic route, to Swakopmund, often fondly referred to as the "playground of

Namibia" where the rest of the day is spent at leisure.  
**Classic: Overnight at Hansa Hotel Breakfast.**  
**Superior: Overnight at Swakopmund Luxury Suites - Breakfast and marine cruise.**

**Day 5 | Tuesday**  
**DAMARALAND**  
Today our journey continues through Uis past the Brandberg, Namibia's highest mountain (2 579m), into the Damaraland, one of the least populated and most geologically diverse areas in Africa.

This harsh, rocky environment is home to the elusive desert elephant, the black rhino and free-roaming antelope species.

We arrive at our lodge in the afternoon, where we have the remaining day at leisure.  
**Classic: Overnight at Ondjamba Hills Breakfast.**  
**Superior: Overnight at Twyfelfontein Adventure Camp or similar - Breakfast and dinner.**

**Day 6 | Wednesday**  
**DAMARALAND / BRANDBERG**  
Enjoy a hearty breakfast overlooking the breathtaking scenery of Damaraland. Embark on a nature drive exploring the area. If you are lucky, you might see the elusive desert elephant. The rest of the day you can relax next to the pool, following one of the walking trails.

**Classic: Overnight at Ondjamba Hills Breakfast, picnic light lunch.**  
**Superior: Overnight at Twyfelfontein Adventure Camp or similar - Breakfast, picnic lunch and dinner.**

**Day 7 | Thursday**  
**ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK**  
Start our day in Twyfelfontein, a UNESCO heritage site where Bushman communities engraved and painted over 2 500 pictures some 6 000 years ago!

After a visit to the nearby Living Museum of the Damara, we proceed to the Petrified Forest - a geological phenomenon.

View the Welwitschia mirabilis plant - the oldest living desert plant in the world. Our onward journey takes us to the wildlife heaven of Namibia - the Etosha National Park.  
**Classic: Overnight at Etosha Safari Camp - Breakfast.**  
**Superior: Overnight at Epacha Game Lodge & Spa - Breakfast and dinner.**

**Day 8 | Friday**  
**ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK**  
Today is devoted purely to the abundant wildlife found in the Etosha National Park, which surrounds a parched salt desert known as the Etosha Pan. The park is home to 4 of the 'Big 5' - elephant, lion, leopard and rhino. Despite the size of the Etosha National Park, only the southern edge of the pan is accessible

to visitors. Game viewing in the park is primarily focussed around the waterholes, some of which are spring fed and some supplied from a borehole, ideal places to sit and watch over 114 different game species, or for an avid birder, more than 340 bird species.

**Classic: Overnight at Etosha Safari Camp Breakfast.**  
**Superior: Overnight at Epacha Game Lodge & Spa - Breakfast and dinner.**

**Day 9 | Saturday**  
**ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK**  
Today your guide takes you on a last game drive through the Etosha National Park. We may encounter animal species we have not seen the previous day. In the afternoon we continue onwards to our lodge, where we enjoy the rest of the afternoon at leisure.  
**Classic: Overnight at Sachsenheim Guest Farm - Breakfast.**  
**Superior: Overnight at Mushara Collection Breakfast and dinner.**

**Day 10 | Sunday**  
**DEPARTURE**  
Time permitting, en route to Windhoek, we may stop at the famous wood carvers market in Okahandja or the craft market in Windhoek. Spend the afternoon at your accommodation in Windhoek or transferred to the international airport.  
**Classic: Breakfast.**  
**Superior: Breakfast.**
