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The expansive Kavango Zambezi (KAZA) Trans-frontier Conservation Area (TFCA) is the world's largest terrestrial TFCA at approximately 520,000 km². Occupying part of the Okavango and Zambezi river basins, it encompasses areas within the borders of Angola, Botswana, Namibia, Zambia and Zimbabwe, and includes 36 formally proclaimed protected areas made up of a host of game reserves, forest reserves, game management areas, communal lands and conservation and tourism concession areas designated for use of natural resources. The most well-known components of KAZA are the Chobe National Park, Hwange National Park, Kafue National Park, the Okavango Delta and Victoria Falls. KAZA is the largest wildlife conservation area in the world and is home to the greatest concentration of free-roaming elephants anywhere.

Day to Day

Day 1 - Location – Katima Mulilo



On arrival at Kasane Airport you will be transferred to the Namibian border. After clearing customs and immigration, change vehicles and continue to Caprivi Mutoya Lodge. The transfer takes approximately 2 hours.

Katima Mulilo, the capital of the Zambezi region in Namibia, is situated on the Zambezi River in the Caprivi Strip. Ethnic tribes living in the town today includes Subia, Yeyi, Mafwe, Totela, Mbukushu, Mbalangwe and Khwe, each with their own language. Katima Mulilo has a hot semi-arid climate and the rainy season is from November to March. The dry season, April to October is less humid, but with warm weather and chilly mornings.

Caprivi Mutoya Lodge

Description

Caprivi Mutoya Lodge is situated in a small riverine forest, delicately perched on the tranquil banks of a backwater lake connected to the Zambezi River, just 24 kilometers east of Katima Mulilo. Caprivi Mutoya Lodge & Campsite offer a diverse range of accommodation. Cosy rooms, for the adventurous spirit a tent or the rustic charm of a campsite.

Day 2 & 3 Location – Bwabwata National Park



After breakfast you will be transferred to Kazile Island Lodge, a road transfer of approximately 2 hours and 40 minutes.

Kazile Island is a special paradise that can only be reached by boat. Here, herds of buffalo and elephant traverse the wet Zambezi landscape. Sitatunga, an elusive aquatic antelope, is often spotted along the floodplains and marshes. Fall in love with this enigmatic corner of Namibia as the sun rises over the tree canopies. Enjoy the sounds of birds chirping from your tent, explore the waterways and absorb the ambiance of this beautiful wilderness.

Kazile Island Lodge

Meal Basis: Dinner, Bed & Breakfast. Activities include afternoon boat cruise, morning bushwalk, a visit to the Sijwa sustainable project, afternoon and morning game drives.



Description

Kazile Island Lodge is situated on a private island on the banks of the Kwando River, within the heart of KAZA. Kazile together with its sister lodge Nambwa are the only lodges to be uniquely situated within the Bwabwata National Park. The Lodge offers ten Meru tents nestled within a Mangosteen forest. The tents overlook the Kwando River as well as the expansive floodplains between the Island and the famous Horseshoe Bend.

Day 4 & 5 Location - Northern Chobe National Park

After an early morning game drive and breakfast you will be transferred to the Namibia / Botswana border post where you will clear customs and immigration, change vehicles and continue on your transfer to Muchenje Safari Lodge. The transfer takes approximately 3 hours and 30 minutes.

Chobe National Park is Botswana's first national park, and also the most biologically diverse. Located in the north of the country, it is Botswana's third largest park, after Central Kalahari Game Reserve and Gemsbok National Park, and has one of the greatest concentrations of game in all of Africa. This park is noted for having a population of lions which

prey on elephants, mostly calves or juveniles, but also sub-adults.

Muchenje Safari Lodge

With wonderful views of the Chobe River and the seasonal flood plains, its position means that it is far away from the bustle of Kasane yet just two hours from the magnificent Victoria Falls. Muchenje Safari Lodge is independently owned and run. It is within the Chobe Forest Reserve, just a short drive from Chobe National Park. There are no fences between the Western Chobe Park Boundary and the Lodge; animals roam free. Chobe is renowned for its prolific wildlife and huge concentrations of game. Muchenje prides itself in the variety and quality of safari experiences, allowing you to explore the Chobe and all its wonders. There are wonderful views over the Chobe River from the main lodge and all of the luxurious cottages. Being owner run, Muchenje Safari Lodge allows for a more personalised service and homely atmosphere. With experienced managers and guides looking after you every step of the way.

Day 6 & 7 - Location – Victoria Falls

After breakfast you will be transferred to Victoria Falls, clearing customs and immigration at both the Botswana and Zimbabwe border posts. The transfer takes approximately 2 hours.

Victoria Falls is a waterfall on the Zambezi River in southern Africa, which provides habitat for several unique species of plants and animals. It is located on the border between Zambia and Zimbabwe and is considered to be one of the world's largest waterfalls due to its width of 1,708 m (5,604 ft).
