

Dear valued partner in travel,

The Western Cape is currently experiencing extreme weather conditions, causing damage and disruption throughout the province. Traffic officers from the City of Cape Town are busy dealing with minor incidents and obstructions caused by bad weather. Sections of Baden Powell Drive remain closed due to hazardous conditions. The road is shut between Strandfontein Road, and Capricorn Circle in Muizenberg, as well as between Oscar Mpetha and Mew Way in Khayelitsha. Chapman's Peak Drive is also closed.

The Somerset Mall is closed after being blown off by the relentless winds. In response to the unprecedented Level 9 weather warning, Table Mountain National Park has taken precautionary measures to guarantee public safety. All hiking trails, mountain biking routes and horse riding trails within the park are closed due to anticipated adverse weather conditions.

Fire has broken out in Fish Hoek, affecting areas along Simon's Town Road below Echo Road and surrounding residential properties. The fire situation is exacerbated by strong gale-force winds, which increase the possibility of flare-ups.
