Make your own way to the Ocean Blue Adventure Shop, located in the Milkwood Centre, Hopwood Street, Plettenberg Bay.

Prior to your departure, you will be equipped with a life jacket. Enjoy a pre-trip briefing where the guide will explain the trip and safety aspects.

As soon as you board the boat, your trip will commence with an exciting beach launch through the ocean surf. Weather and sea conditions permitting, you will head out past the bird sanctuary, making your way along the Keurbooms Beach towards Arch Rock. Along the way, you will generally encounter bottlenose dolphins and the rare Indo-Pacific humpback dolphin as well as various shark species. From Arch Rock you will cross the bay, crossing the point of Robberg Peninsula where you may see groups of whales and pods of dolphins. You will get a chance to view roughly 8 to 10 000 Cape Fur Seals on the Robberg Peninsula.

Cruising back along the inside of Robberg, you will see the unique geology and you may be able to see the growing Cape Fur Seal Colony. Finally, you will head back along Robberg Beach, whilst enjoying a brief run-down of the area's history. After passing the Beacon Island Hotel built on the site of the original whaling station, you will end your experience with an exhilarating "James Bond" style landing onto Central Beach.
